Art History Inspiration

As a child, D'Adamo showed a keen interest for painting and drawing and so took private lessons for a number of years. It was only in 2010 that he returned to art, making it his all-consuming focus. D'Adamo's work draws on the 20th Century French and Italian 'Informale' movements. At times he takes inspiration from Lyrical Abstraction and Tachisme and the works of Alberto Burri and the American Expressionist painter Willem de Kooning.

Musicality Meets Painting

Through his paintings, D'Adamo is seeking a wordless language by which to express what would otherwise be impossible. Being a musician himself, D'Adamo is deeply fascinated by the relationship between music and art and attempts to transpose the formal elements of one onto the other. The compositions of his paintings mimic the rhythms of musical language, with decisive staccato marks, broad sweeping brush strokes, and a vibrant, highly pigmented color palette that enlivens the canvas. What themes do you pursue in your art? Are they rather content-related themes or is the emotional aspect decisive? Do you have a specific example that is reflected in one of your works, ideally one in your SINGULART portfolio?

Fd'A: Works from different series are driven by different themes and are consequently painted differently. Yet certain themes such as the sense of time, memory, the dialogue between music and images and a desire for unresolved complexity tries to pervade most of my works. For me the aesthetic, emotional and content-related aspects cannot be separated, and they emerge on the canvas one from the other.

Taking the work *Hydra* for example, from the Manifesti series, here the main search is building a moment of balance suspended between the painting's complete manifestation and its visual dissolving. Its static image tries to suggest a movement both forward and backward in time, appearing mysterious and lyrical, with a musical unfolding.


